

2021 NSWACT XC / Snow Australia Nordic Shelter Use Covid-19 Operational Guidelines Summary (23 June 2021)

Conditions of Entry into the Perisher Nordic Shelter:

- All users who enter the building (front door or external doors from the deck) **MUST** check-in using the SERVICE NSW QR Code or sign in the log in the Entry Foyer. QR Codes are located at all entry points for convenience of checking in. You may be asked by Nordic Shelter representatives to show that you have checked in.
 - You may not enter if you are unwell or exhibiting COVID-like symptoms.
 - You may not enter if you have been in a designated COVID hotspot during the previous 14 days. This link will inform you of current Hot Spots - <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates>
 - You may not enter if you have been in close or casual contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or who is awaiting COVID-19 test results.
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- Enter at own risk. People using the Nordic Shelter are expected to take responsibility for assessing their own risk of acquiring COVID-19.
 - The Nordic Shelter and Snow Australia will not be liable for any health costs that a user may incur because of visiting the Perisher Nordic Shelter.
 - All users are required to obey any lawful direction from the Shelter Managers or authorised delegate. Serious breaches of protocol may result in expulsion from the Perisher Nordic Shelter.
 - All users must comply with all applicable physical distance and personal hygiene requirements (presently 1.5m), number restrictions, hand and sneeze/cough hygiene requirements and cleaning and disinfecting requirements.
 - Cleaning stations and hand sanitiser are provided in convenient locations throughout the Shelter – use them!

Public Areas (North Room, South Room):

- Occupancy – 20 people seated in each room with the expectation that there may be additional people retrieving belongings, using the kitchens, etc.
- Time limit - 30 minutes occupation is requested, particularly in busy periods, to allow others to have access to the facility. Please don't hog the seating!
- Users of the North and South Rooms are required to clean the surfaces of areas they use within the Nordic Shelter before departure (e.g. tables, chairs, benches, shelves) using the paper towels and cleaner provided.
- Ventilation - Exterior and interior doors will be left open or ajar to aid fresh air circulation.
- Bag storage – Allowed. Large groups will be encouraged to have a tent for their belongings outside in order to avoid large numbers of people entering the building before and after lessons, race events etc.
- Toilets - Restored to Men/Women and Unisex. Occupancy limit of 2 in each room.
- Access stairs – NO access to the upstairs area via the internal stairs at any time. Don't access the upstairs area at all without an invitation.
- The Nordic Shelter will not have capacity for people to haven from bad weather. Plan your day to be prepared for differing weather conditions.
- If you need to speak with Geraldine (0488 955 325) or Arnold (0437 471 615), text them first. They will arrange a place to speak with you.

Public Kitchens:

- Occupancy - Limits of 2 people at a time in each kitchen.
- Services - Hot water urns, sandwich presses, microwaves and sinks/detergent.
- Utensils - Users are to provide their own cutlery, cups and crockery.
- Coffee, tea, sugar (in individual sachets), milk, stirrers and paper towels are provided.
- North kitchen - No seating or bag storage.

Wax Room:

- Occupancy - limit of 3 people.
- Time limit – 10 minutes and one pair of skis.
- Benches – two wax benches and one scraping bench available for use.
- Wax at home – skiers are encouraged to wax their skis at home prior to arrival at the trails.

Ski Store:

- Occupancy - limit of 3 people

Outside seating:

- Portable seats (milk crates) will be available for seating and storage to encourage people to socialise and eat outside.

Meeting Room:

- Occupancy – 5 people. Access only for managers, NSWACT XC coaches, event officials.
- Access – Enter only through exterior door, not via stairs.

Race Room:

- Occupancy – 2 people. During events occupancy will be at the discretion of the contracted event timer and may include additional officials for short periods.
- Access – Enter only through exterior door, not via stairs.

Manager's Flat:

- Protection of Managers' health and privacy is paramount.
- Visitors – only at the invitation of the manager.
- Access – If invited, enter only through exterior door, not via internal stairs.

Triggers for Closure of Nordic Shelter:

- Request of Snow Australia or the Nordic Shelter Management Group.
- Direction of NSW Public Health orders.
- If the Nordic Shelter is to be closed, all bags and belongings located inside the public areas. will be deposited outside the Shelter near the front doors.
